



*Mosiah 18:5 Now, there was in Mormon a fountain of pure water, and Alma resorted thither, there being near the water a thicket of small trees, where he did hide himself in the daytime from the searches of the king.*

The proposed location must be a relatively short distance from the king and should be located in a place where the king's men could not find him. The scripture implies that the "thicket" is near the baptismal site but not necessarily in the same place.

*Mosiah 18:30 . . .the waters of Mormon, in the forest that was near the waters of Mormon; yea, the place of Mormon, the waters of Mormon, the forest of Mormon, how beautiful are they to the eyes of them who there . . .*

This scripture suggests that the baptismal site should be in a place of beauty.
