

Nixtun Chich is a Proposed Major Mulekite Site

Provide strong evidence that Nixtun Chich was a major Mulekite site, a possible location for Christ's visits and an integral part of the Jaredite hunting grounds. In addition, its timeframe is an excellent match for the Mulekites.

Scriptures:

Ether 10:19 "...they did go into the land southward, to hunt food for the people of the land, for the land was covered with animals of the forest. 20 And they built a great city by the narrow neck of land, by the place where the sea divides the land.

Omi 1:17 And at the time that Mosiah discovered them, they had become exceedingly numerous. And had many wars and serious contentions.

It is likely that their population exceeded one hundred thousand and they were responsible for many of the ancient cities in the Peten during the preclassic period. It's likely that some of the contentions were amongst themselves, but it is also highly probable that the more part of the contentions were with the Jaredites. The Jaredites were just to the north of them.



Nixtun Chich is an Ideal Location for Christs Visit

Nixtun Chich is an excellent candidate for the place of Christs visit. This is because of (1) its central location. It is near the Narrow Neck of Land, a place that separates the land southward and land northward, (2) it is near a major travel route and (3) it's on the shoreline of lake Peten Itza, which provides excellent accessibility and it's a very desirable place to be.
