- •It is considered to be a very important king.
- •The material of the statue was made from a unique stone that came from a long distance, which adds to the importance of this Stela.
- •The tools that the king is holding in his hand are farming tools. It is hard to understand why a king should have farming tools, when he should be living the life of a king.
- •His boots are of a European style.
- •The monkey face is a Maya traditions that represents a God from an early creation.
- •It's possible that he was a king in the Book of Mormon that was honored at a later time.
