
This Structure must be Similar to the One Below At Least Ten Km Long


Alma 50:34... they did head them, by the narrow pass.. By the sea, on the west and on the east.

Alma 52:9 ...they should **fortify the land Bountiful** and secure the narrow pass which led into the land northward...








The Fortification Must Include a Narrow Passageway

This picture is a representation of how the Book of Mormon portrays the Narrow Passageway



The Narrow Pass

The picture to the right is the narrow pass that is located within the massive 12 Km fortification that is situated between the proposed West Sea and the East Sea.



Scriptural Documentation for the Narrow Pass

Alma 50:34... they did head them, by the narrow pass which led by the sea into the land northward, yea, by the sea, on the west and on the east.

Mormon 2:29 And the Lamanites did give unto us the land northward, yea, even to the narrow passage which led into the land southward

Scriptural Documentation for the East Sea and West Sea

The East Sea and the West Sea

The scriptures are very clear about the existence of the West Sea and East Sea. However, in this model, these seas (lakes) are obscure and could cast doubts on claims that the Bajo's are remnants of the East and West Seas. We also have to rely on three realities: (1) There are over two hundred evidences that point to the Target Area and (2) There is scientific proof that these two Bajoes were ancient lakes (seas) during Book of Mormon times and (3) the other ten features of the Narrow Neck complex are very real and provide a major support for the ancient seas.


The topography map at the top the pages shows two-2-kilometer gaps between the end of the fortification and the edge of the Bajo's. This is solid evidence that there were times in the past where water level had to be much higher in order to meet the ends fortifications.


Otherwise, the fortifications would have no value.

The Justification for Inland Seas

The Book of Mormon never referred to inland bodies of water as lakes. In the holy land they were called seas.

Michael D Coe, a prominent Mayan archeologist, claims that the rainfall during Preclassic times was 20% higher

Both ends of the 12 km fortification are currently 2 km away from the waters edge, this implies that the current water levels are much lower.


Dr. Richard Hansen, the premier archeologist in the Meridor Basin (the location that is adjacent to the proposed Narrow Neck of Land) said the most of the Bajo's were filled with water for decades at a time Cortez's communications with his Emperor claim the bodies of water in the northern Petén appeared to be an extension of the oceans.

Dr Ray Matheny has reported that during high rainfall periods the Bajo's fill up with water and some become huge lakes. He said that some are large enough to see the curvature of the earth.

Many of the superhighways in the Mirador Basin were raised quite high. Could this be due to periods of excessive rainfall?

Stalagmite growth studies during the Preclassic Period in the Yucatan reveal that rainfall levels were much higher during the Book of Mormon period.
