Scriptural Connections

Alma 31:3 Now the Zoramites had gathered themselves together in a land which they called <u>Antionum</u>, which was east of the <u>land of Zarahemla</u>, which lay nearly bordering upon the <u>seashore</u>, which was south of the <u>land of Jershon</u>, which also bordered upon the <u>wilderness south . . .</u>

Alma 43:15 . . .armies of the Lamanites had gathered together in the land of <u>Antionum</u>, behold, the armies of the Nephites were prepared to meet them in the land of Jershon.

Alma 43:22 . . . they departed out of the <u>land of Antionum</u> into the <u>wilderness</u>, and took their journey round about in the wilderness, away by the <u>head of the river Sidon</u>, that they might come into the <u>land of Manti</u>.

Alma 8:3 . . .Alma departed from thence (<u>Zarahemla</u>) and took his journey over into the <u>land of Melek</u>, on the <u>west of the river Sidon</u>, on the <u>west by the borders of the wilderness.</u>

Alma 8:6 So that when he had finished his work at Melek he departed thence, and traveled three days' journey on the <u>north of the land of</u> Melek; and he came to a city which was called Ammonihah.

Alma 2:36 And they fled before the Nephites (from <u>Zarahemla</u>) towards the <u>wilderness which was west and north, away beyond the borders of the land</u>; and the Nephites did pursue them with their might, and did slay them.

Alma 2:37 Yea, they were met on every hand, and slain and driven, until they were scattered on the west, and on the north, until they had reached the wilderness, which was called Hermounts
